















BRIEFING EXTERNAL ORGANISATIONS ON COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

	<p>Visitors to the Kozloduy NPP site can be allowed access after filling in a Declaration form and submitting it to the Security Division</p>
	<p><u>Representatives of contractors</u> that do not have a temporary site pass with a photo and need to go through automated access system to perform works on the plant site shall be allowed access after submitting to the Security Division a document issued by an accredited laboratory to certify a negative PCR-test made within 72 hours prior to starting the works.</p> <p>A temporary pass with a photo ensuring access to the site and left for safe-keeping with the Security Division can be unblocked and returned to its owner after the latter submits to the Security Division a document issued by an accredited laboratory certifying a negative PCR test made within 72 hours prior to returning and unblocking the pass.</p> <p>No PCR-test is required from external organisations that supply goods to Kozloduy NPP as per contract. These contractors shall seek from the Commercial Department approval of their applications for access.</p> <p>No PCR test is required to obtain access to the plant Occupational Health Service. The Head of the Occupational Health Service can approve access applications of individuals.</p> <p>Access to the Kozloduy NPP site for <u>foreign citizens</u> shall be allowed only if a document by an accredited laboratory verifying a negative result of a PCR test performed up to 72 hours before arrival in the country has been submitted to the plant Security Division;</p>
	<p>It is obligatory for the personnel working at the Kozloduy NPP site to come to work only in good health. Should any symptoms arise indicating even a slight change in your health status during working time, immediately call the plant Occupational Health Service at ☎ 21 21.</p>

	<p>Protective half face masks shall be used on the site of Kozloduy NPP:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Indoors, with more than one person in the premise/office; - Outdoors, when workers are positioned within less than 1.5 metres from one another; - When working in the controlled area, in addition to the protective equipment required for operation in ionizing radiation environment; - When using elevators, going along corridors, overhead bridges and staircases; - Going in/out through the plant main gates.
	<p>Use of elevators and communication inside them shall be limited.</p>
	<p>The plant access control procedure includes monitoring of body temperature upon entry. When entering buildings with thermal body cameras installed, stop at the places marked with a red dot, and if wearing glasses and/or a hat (hard hat), take them off and look at the respective thermal imaging camera for one second.</p>
	<p>When passing through the metal detectors of the main gates, do not leave any metal objects in the object boxes; instead, hold them above the shoulders in a way that allows the police officers to see them.</p>
	<p>It is obligatory to disinfect the workplaces at least once every three hours, as well as upon arrival at the workplace.</p>
	<p>It is obligatory to wash and disinfect your hands after each entry into work offices/premises/common facilities (toilets, canteens, smoking areas, elevators).</p>



	Ventilate regularly the work premises - every hour for 10 minutes.
	It is mandatory to observe social distancing (at least 1.5 metres distance from each other) during work, shift turnover, or smoking.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Eating and drinking shall take place only in the designated places;- Sit alone at a table when having meals at the plant canteen.

In case of non-compliance with, and/or violation of the established rules, the staff access to the nuclear power plant site shall be terminated.
